#### Cherry Wood Color

The color of cherry heartwood (older wood present at the center) is pinkish to reddish-brown, while the surrounding sapwood is cream or yellowish color. Immediately after harvesting [cherry trees](#), the wood color has a lighter shade. With time, it darkens its color shade to deep reddish-brown, giving a more elegant look.

#### Cherry Wood Density

In terms of hardness, cherry wood is moderately hard, strong and medium weight. The fine grains along with smooth and sleek texture are remarkable cherry wood characteristics for use in wood works. In short, it takes up any type of wood finishing. Some of the best finishes for cherry wood are natural and light alternatives.

#### Cherry Wood Machinability

In comparison to oak, maple and other hardwood alternatives, cherry wood is more pliable and flexible. At the same time, this attractive colored wood is strong and possesses resistant property. All these cherry wood characteristics make it an excellent choice for [flooring](#) and making home furniture.

#### Cherry Wood in Furniture

Cherry wood is perfect for use in nearly all types of wood works, and the most common usage

In moist and humid condition, it absorbs moisture and expands a little. On the contrary, it slightly contracts during dry and cold winter months.

Proper treatment and curing approaches are done before using cherry wood lumber. In the market, you will get different types of furniture based on cherry wood. The solid cherry wood furniture is exclusively made from cherry. While faux cherry is devoid of cherry wood, cherry veneers are created with cherry wood on the top layer supported by other wood on the underside. The price tag of cherry wood furniture is lower than other types of hardwood. So, aren't cherry wood characteristics excellent for use in flooring and furniture? As per your personal preference, you can opt for lighter cherry wood color or the darker shade. While lighter shade looks great for personalized furniture, the darker version adds a formal touch to the interior decor.
